







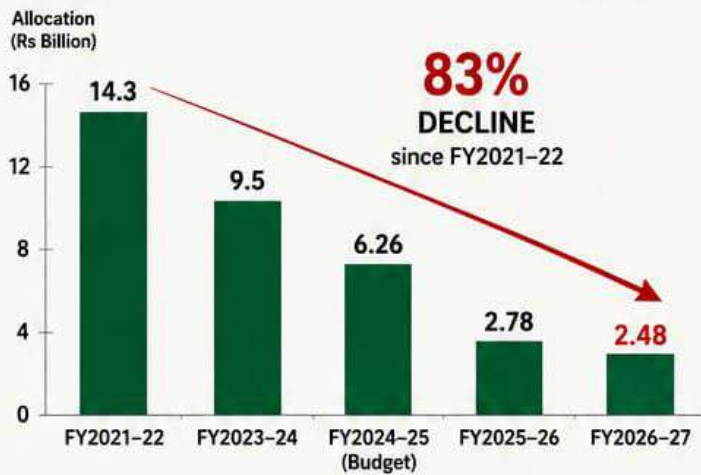
Pakistan's Climate Ministry Budget in PSDP 2026-27: Smaller Allocation, Bigger Questions



PSDP allocation for Climate Change & Environmental Coordination Division continues to decline, while climate-relevant spending is spread across multiple sectors and provinces.

KEY TAKEAWAYS

- Climate Ministry allocation has fallen by **83%** over the last five years.
- Only **0.25%** of the federal PSDP is allocated to the Climate Ministry.
- 94%** of the Climate Ministry's PSDP allocation is in a single project.
- Climate spending is mainstreamed across sectors, provinces and special areas.
- The PSDP does not provide a consolidated picture of total climate spending or outcomes.
